This Indenture made the 9 Day of February Anno Domini 1764 Between *Holliday*  
 Revel and Grace Revel his wife of Northampton county of the one part and Moses  
 Johnson of Isle of Wight county of the other Part Witnesseth that the said  
 Holliday Revel and his Wife Grace Revel for and in consideration of the sum of  
 thirty Pound current money of Virginia to him in hand Paid by the said Moses  
 Johnson before the sign Sealing and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
 on the said Holliday Revel and Wife Grace Revel doth hereby acknowledge themselves  
 fully satisfied and paid hath granted Bargained sold enfeof and confirmed and by  
 these Presents doth grant Bargain and Sell and Confirm unto the said Moses Johnson  
 his Heirs and assigns for ever one tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton  
 county butted and Bounded as followeth beginning at a white oak a corner Tree between  
 Thomas Jones and William Jones and running a line of market trees to a Hickory  
 another corner tree between Thomas Jones and Arthur Smith and thence along  
 a line of market Trees to scacock Swamp run and thence up scacock run to  
 a persimmon tree another corner tree and so up a Branch to a Pine another  
 corner tree and so a new line of market Trees to the first station it be by  
 estimation one Hundred acres be the same more or less and also the reversion  
 and reversions and remainder and remainders to have and to hold the said  
 Land & Tenements with all the appurtenances therunto belonging with all & singular  
 woods & underwoods timbers and trees ways & waters and water courses with all the  
 profits therunto belonging unto the said Moses Johnson his heirs and assigns for ever  
 by these Presents in manner & form following (to wit) that the said Holliday Revel  
 and his wife Grace Revel hath lawfully writ fully seized of an estate fee  
 simple of on the said Land & Premises herein before granted or mentioned and  
 doth hereby warrant and defend the same from him the said Holliday Revel  
 and his wife Grace Revel their Heirs and all and every other person or persons
