This Indenture made the fourteenth day of Anno Domini one thousand
seven Hundred & sixty four and in the fourth year of the reign of his Majesty
King George the third Between Jonathan Edwards of the County of Southampton
of the one part and Nathan Edwards of the County of aforesaid of the other
part witnesseth that the said Jonathan Edwards for an inconsideration
of the sum of forty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him on hand paid
by the said Nathan Edwards at or before the executing & delivering of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Jonathan Edwards doth thereby
acknowledge he the said Jonathan Edwards hath granted Bargained and sold
Aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant Bargain
and sell Alien convey and confirm unto the said Nathan Edwards his Heirs and
assigns for ever Part of two tracts or parcels of land lying lying & being in
the County of Southampton and on the west side of the Black water River
and bounded as followeth to wit the first parcel or part of a tract contains
one hundred and fifty acres by estimation be the same more or less and
bounded as followeth beginning at a marked Pine tree that divided the land
formerly Anthony Lewis and William Johnson running east along the said
Johnson line to three marked Oaks thence north west along a line of marked
trees to a hickory made a corner tree thence west and by south a long line
of marked trees to a red Oak thence west along a line of marked trees to
a white Oak being the aforesaid Lewis corner tree so running down a
Branch to the beginning the above said Land was formerly the property
of the above named Anthony Lewis and by him sold and conveyed by deed
to one James Peain which deed Bears date the 14 day of October 1740
and proved in the court of the county of Solemnright to which for Bounds more
particular we refer & by several conveyances now the property of the said Jonathan
Edwards: The other part or parcel of land contains nearly seven acres being the half
of a new survey for one hundred and fifty four acres and begins at the Beginning
Pine Tree mentioned in the above land at the mouth of the said Branch
which stands in the edge of the peacocks or low grounds thence south westerly
to a dogwood and thence to a white Oak and so along a line of marked trees made

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
