This Indenture made the thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty four. Between Joseph Griffin of the county of Southampton of the one part & Harmon Harris of the same county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Griffin for an consideration of the sum of twenty Pounds & six shillings & six pence money to him in hand paid by the said Harmon Harris the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge that he hath granted bargained & sold Aliaid in full & conform and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien in full & conform unto the said Harmon Harris his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred & fifty Acres by estimation more or less situated lying and being in the said county of Southampton being a part of a larger tract of land which was granted to John Griffin by patent bearing date the thirteenth day of March one thousand seven hundred & forty three which land the said Joseph Griffin held from his father John Griffin and bounded as followeth (to wit) beginning at a small pine a corner tree in John Harris line in the hopstick percross thence along the said Harris line to a pine across tree in the said Harris line thence to a sweet gum in a pond a corner tree in Allen Cocha line thence along the said Cocha line to a white oak a corner tree of Joseph Griffins thence along the said Griffins line to a corner tree of Joseph Griffins thence along the said Griffins line to the beginning and also all waste underwoods profits commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto and also the reversion and reversion remainder & remainder & right services of the said premises and every part thereof and all the estate right title Interest Use propriety Inheritance claim & demand whatsoever of them

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
