 forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the country of
 Southampton and on the north side of black creek and bounded as followeth
 to wit beginning in the gum branch at black creek and a long the said Branch
 to a gum corner tree then a line of market trees to the branch formerly
 called the milas branch running to the mouth of the gum branch and then
 a line of market trees to Cap^t Joseph Godwin's old line from the said Godwin's
 line to the little perscove to a pine corner tree a long the said perscove
 to pine corner tree then running a line of market trees to black creek
 along the said Run of the said creek to the gum Branch at the
 first station, the first station of the said land was granted to Barnabas
 Mackenney a certain indenture of a patent granted By Alexander Spotswood
 one hundred acres more or less and from the said Mackenney to George Harris
 the elder and from him to his son William Harris as a legacy in his last
 will & testament one hundred and thirteen acres land more or less situated
 lying and being in the country of Southampton and bounded as followeth (to wit)
 beginning at a poplar in the long branch then by a line of market trees
 to a gum in William Harris old line Running up the said line to a
 scrubby white oak then a line of market trees to a pine on the side of the
 long branch then down the said branch to the beginning being part of a patent
 granted to Joseph Godwin bearing date the 25th of July 1746 from Godwin to

 there to belonging to him the said John Council and his heirs and assigns
 forever and the said William Harris and Charity Harris his wife
 doth hereby agree to come with the said John Council that at the delivery
 of these presents he had a fee simple right in the said premises and
 have lawful title to dispose of the same free and unencumbered from all debts
 taxes Bargains gifts grants rights or titles of Dower to the only persons
 and behoof of the said John Council his heirs & assigns forever
 according to the true intent & meaning of these presents of the said W^m
 Harris & Charity Harris his wife all the aforesaid two hundred and thirteen
 acres of land more or less with all houses and appurtenances from
 the claim of them the said William Harris & Charity his wife or either of
 their heirs to the only aforesaid John Council and his heirs &
 assigns well warrant & forever defend by these presents In witness
 whereof the said W^m Harris & Charity his wife have to these presents
 Interchangably set their Hands and affixed their seals the day and
