

Devised by the last will and Testament of John Person Died to Thomas Person,
 which said Decease is in the words following to wit: Virginia. At a General Court held
 at the Capital the eleventh Day of October 1763 John Person an Infant by William
 Blunt his next Friend plaintiff against John Person and William Person defendants
 in Chancery. A report being made and returned between the parties in the words following
 to wit: pursuant to an Order of the Honorable the General Court bearing date
 the 14 day of April 1762 we the Subscribers by and with the consent of the Plaintiff
 and Deft. in the said Order mentioned have divided and set apart to the Plaintiff
 John Person the younger the following lands as and for one third part of the lands
 devised by John Person died to his son Thomas Person, that is to say beginning
 at an ancient white oak standing in the outside line in the swamp above
 the breckey necks, then by a line of market trees nearly by the run of the
 swamp to the thoroughfare then up a small Branch to the head thereof
 then by a line of market trees to a white oak a corner tree in the back line
 between John Person's Land and Benjamin Harris's then beginning again on
 Person's Branch at the mouth of a small Branch and running up that to the
 head thereof to a market Gum Sapling then by a line of market trees to a hickory
 standing in the back line of the said eighty acres of land Devised to the said
 Thomas Person Died, then across the back line to Powell's Branch including
 all the land between the before mentioned line which we estimate to be
 four hundred & fifty acres of land (be the same more or less) and estimate
 it to be one equal third part in value of all the lands Devised by the said
 John Person died to his son Thomas, all the remainder of the said Lands
 devised by the said John Person Died to his son Thomas, never apart to the
 defendants, we also set apart the negro boy Perry and a negro Girl call as for
 one third part of the slaves and their Increase devised by the said John Person Died
 to Thomas Person, to John Person the younger he paying to the defendants two pound
 six shillings of eight Pence current money. the other Slaves Devised by the
 said Testator and their Increase we set apart to the defendants certified
 under our hands this 6 day October 1763 David Edmunds John Burgess,
 Absolved. In the or consideration whereof it is decreed and ordered that the
 partition and division aforesaid in form aforesaid made stand and be held
 firm & stable between the parties and all persons claiming under them and
 that the parties bear their own costs signed by Benj. Waller together with
 all houses out houses edifices buildings roads ways and waters to the same
 belonging or appertaining and the revenues & profits, remainder & profits of them
 and of the profits thereof and all the estate right title and interest of them
 the said John Person of Dorcas his wife of and to the same to have and to
 hold their said part of the said Lands set apart to John Person and William
 Person by decree aforesaid to the said William Person his heirs of Assigns forever
 to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Person his heirs of Assigns
 forever, and the said John Person of Dorcas his wife for themselves their Heirs of Assigns
