This Indenture made this fourth day of December one thousand seven hundred
and eighty four and in the reign of our sovereign Lord George the third by the grace of God of Great Britain
France of Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Between Jesse Brown of Southampton County
of the one part & James Cooper of the aforesaid county of the other part Witnesseth that the said
James Cooper for an inconsideration of the sum of forty five pounds current money of
Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Brown at and before the sealing and
delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Cooper doth hereby acknowledge
he the said James Cooper hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed confirmed and by
these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Jesse
Brown his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the
county of Southampton and parish of Norway and bounded as follows beginning at a Gum
by the side of the Cypress swamp then west eighty poles to a Gum a corner tree of John Barnes
land then by a line then west one hundred & twenty poles to a red oak then south twenty five
degrees west eighty eight poles to a Maple in John Turners line thence by the said Turners
line south thirty degrees sixty six poles to a pine then south thirty five degrees west eighty
two poles to a Hickory then south five degrees east sixty eight poles to a white oak then
south twenty five degrees east eighty seven poles to a Hickory then south eighty five
degrees east fifty eight poles to a red oak then north fifty degrees east seventy poles to a
Gum by the side of the Cypress swamp aforesaid then up the run of the said swamp
to the beginning which land was granted to Edward Cobb of the shire of Wright the 16 day
of June 1754 as may appear by patent being five hundred & ninety five acres be the same
more or less including all the land within the said bounds and also all trees woods
underwoods common common of pasture profit commodities advantage Emolument and
benefit whatsoever to the said lands above mentioned belonging or in anywise
appertaining or in or upon the same growing happening or arising and also the reversion
and remainder now being and to remain in the hands and issues of the said Jesse Brown and
