of Newway for the love and good will that I bear unto my son Simon Harris but more
especially for the consideration of the sum of twenty six pounds ten shillings current
money of Virginia have given granted sold and by these presents do fully clearly and
absolutely give grant and sell unto the said Simon Harris one negro boy named Jacob
to him of his heirs to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Simon Harris and his
heirs forever & that he the said William Harris his heirs the said Negro boy to the said
Simon Harris his heirs & assigns against the title claims and demands of him self his
heirs or any persons or persons whatsoever claiming by from or under him shall
and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents as written whereof I the said
William Harris has her unto set his hand & affixed his seal the 6th day of April 1764
