France and Ireland King defender of the faith &c. and in the year of our
Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred sixty five Between Benjamin Barham
of the county of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke of the one part and
Henry Taylor of the said county and parish of the other part Whereby
that for and in consideration of the sum of seventeen pounds ten shillings
current money of Virginia to the said Benjamin Barham in hand paid by the said
Henry Taylor at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof the said Benjamin Barham doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and
therefrom release acquit and discharge the said Henry Taylor his heirs execs and
adorns forever by these presents he the said Benjamin Barham hath granted
bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Henry Taylor his heirs & assigns
forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said county
and parish on the north side of the Cabin Branch containing thirty five acres
be the same more or less it being part of a larger tract purchased of Joshua Smith
by the said Benjamin Barham and bounded as followeth, to wit: Beginning
near the head of the Cabin Branch aforesaid and at the Angelica road on the
said Taylors line thence down the said Taylors line to a corner of the said
