This Indenture made this eighth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five Between Thomas Chappell of Southampton county of the one part and James Chappell of the same county of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Chappell for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds to him in hand paid at or before the enrolling & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said James Chappell and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate & being in the county aforesaid containing one hundred and fifty three acres be it more or ^{less} of bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine thence south fourteen degrees west thirty eight pole to a red oak on the merry branch thence up the ~~same~~ said branch to the mouth of the crotche branch thence up that branch to a pine in James Athisons line thence by the said line to a pine a corner of Arthur Arringtons line thence along the said line to the beginning it being a tract or parcel of land which was made over by Arthur Arrington to Thomas Chappell by a deed bearing date eighth April one thousand seven hundred and sixty two in Southampton court records being thence unto and fifty three acres of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said James Chappell his heirs and assigns forever yielding and paying unto his majesty his heirs and successors the yearly quitrents due for the said land & the said Thomas Chappell doth for himself and his heirs further covenant and agree with the said James Chappell his heirs and assigns that the said Thomas Chappell his heirs & assigns shall & lawfully shall forever defend the above mentioned land and premises unto the said James Chappell his heirs
