This indenture made this twenty seventh day of May in the Year of our Lord god one thousand seven hundred and sixty five And in the fifth year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the third by the grace of god of Great Britain France & Ireland King defender of the faith. Ye J Mary Myrick of the county of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke being widow and relict of Owen Myrick (deceased) that for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Virginia to me in hand paid by my son in Law Benjamin Lewis of the parish & county aforesaid at or before the making and delivery of these presents but more especially for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my said son in Law and for the advancement in the world of the aforesaid Benjamin Lewis I have given granted aliened enjoyed and conveyed And by these presents doth give grant aliening the enfeof and convey unto the said Benjamin Lewis his heirs and assigns forever two negro boy slaves namely Steven & Peter To have & to hold the aforesaid slaves to the proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Lewis his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mary Myrick for her self her heirs executors and assigns doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said Benjamin Lewis his heirs and assigns by these presents that the said Benjamin Lewis hath good right full power and lawful authority to grant sell or convey the aforesaid slaves and that the said slaves is free and clear from all other gifts grants titles wills entails judgments executions and extents and from all other incumbrances whatsoever warranting the same not only against myself my heirs executors and administrators but against all and every other person or persons whatsoever that shall or may claim any right thereto with covenant and forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first above written
