This indenture made this eleventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five Between William Pope of Virginia and county of Southampton of the one part and Jesse Pope of the same county of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Pope for and in consideration of the sum of twenty pounds current money to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said Jesse Pope thereof he the said William Pope doth hereby acquit and discharge hath granted bargained sold and by these presents doth fully & absolutely grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Jesse Pope his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton county on the south side of Tochnathanty swamp containing by estimation one hundred and sixty five acres be the same more or less and bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine in the line branch running up the said branch then running from the said branch to a small Maple in Edwards branch and down the various courses of the run of the said branch to a maple standing at the foot of the round cove then running to a live oak standing in Tochnathanty swamp at the foot of the hog pen branch then running up the said swamp to the beginning together with all houses and buildings thereon with the reversion & reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances to have and to hold all and singular the said land above mentioned and every part & parcel thereof unto the said Jesse Pope his heirs and assigns forever and the said William Pope for himself his heirs executors and assigns the said land and premises and every part thereof against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said Jesse Pope his heirs & assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof the said William Pope hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year above written
