 of our sovereign Lord George the third King of Great Britain &c. Between John Peterson Christian &c. City
 in the colony of Virginia of the one part & Peterson Thorpe of Southampton City in the colony of Virginia
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Peterson for divers good causes & considerations then
 unto moving as well as for in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Virginia
 him in hand paid by the said Peterson Thorpe at & before the executing & delivery of these presents the
 Receipt whereof the said John Peterson doth hereby acknowledge & thereof doth acquit the said Peterson
 Thorpe his heirs & assigns hath granted bargained sold aliened released & confirmed & by
 these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release & confirm unto the said Peterson Thorpe his
 heirs & assigns for ever all his the said John Petersons right title interest claim possession &
 demand of in & to two certain tracts or parcels of land situate lying & being in the county of
 Southampton in the north side of Wetherin River containing in the whole four hundred
 & twenty acres of land be the same more or less which said land was granted to John Peterson
 late of Prince George City by two different patents one tract containing two hundred
