This Indenture made this 11 day of sept. in the sixth year of the reign of our sovereign lord George the third now king of Great Britain &c in the year of our lord christen thousand seven hundred and six
Between Rich^d Hills of the parish of Nottoway & county of Southampton gent of the one part
& William Lane of the same parish & county of the other part
Witnesseth that the Rich^d Hills for & in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the W^m Lane the receipt the Rich^d Hills doth hereby acknowledge & thereto acquit & discharge the W^m Lane his heirs &c & admors by these presents hath granted bargain sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the W^m Lane & to his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the parish & county aforesaid & on the south side of Isaac's swamp containing twenty five acres & bounded according to the most known ancient & reputed bounds thereof which said tract or parcel of land is part of a patent formerly granted to Joseph Exum &c bearing date the day of 17 & by the S. Joseph Exum &c &c &c
to one Robert W^m bounger decd & by the death of the S. Robert is descended &c come to one Joseph Mounger as son & heir at law to the S. Robert which S. Joseph Mounger sold &c &c
