 being in the aforesaid county of Southampton upon the west side of a swamp called &
 known by the name of the Angelica swamp containing by estimation two hundred
 & seventy acres be the same more or less & bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning

 the Angelica swamp aforesaid & up the various courses of the run of the said swamp
