hereby acknowledge & himself therewith fully satisfied hath granted bargained & sold by the
premises doth grant bargain & sell unto the sd In^{Ch} Blithe one certain tract or parcel of land containing
one hundred acres lying & being the county of Sharrington & bounded as followeth To wit beginning
a gum on the South side of a branch a line tree of Bridgman Joyners Sun^{land} land then by the sd
line south thirty degrees east one hundred & thirteen pole to land oak of the same course fifty
seven pole further to a black oak ^{then north thirty degrees west one hundred & forty seven pole to a pine} Then north East one hundred & fifteen pole to a pine by the
side of a branch begun at & down the various courses of the sd branch to the beginning with
all houses orchards fields woods waters & water courses with all privileges immunities
& advantages of any kind nature whatsoever to the same belonging or any wise appur-
taining to the sd land & appurtenances To have & to hold the one hundred acres of land
& appurtenances to the sd In^{Ch} Blithe & his heirs for ever to the only proper use & behoof
of him the sd Blithe his heirs & assigns forever of the said Natham Council doth for him
self his against his heirs or any other person claiming under him the sd premises with
their assigns shall give warrant of for ever defend In Witness whereof he hath hereunto
