paid by the Sth W^m Thomas the receipt whereof the Sth Thomas Blunt doth hereby ack-
ledge hath granted bargained & sold aliened enfeoffed confirmed & by these presents doth
grant bargain & sell aliened & confirmed unto the Sth W^m Thomas his heirs & assigns forever
certain tract or parcel of land containing four hundred & twelve acres lying being
in the county of Southampton on the south side of Netterway river granted unto Thom-
as Blunt by patent bearing date the sixteenth day of Sep^r one thousand seven hundred
& sixty five in the fifth year of our reign of George the third the said patent being a gen-
eral one in particularity & of several references thereto being had may more fully
& at large appear with all woods underwoods profits commodities advantages heredi-
taments & appurtenances whatsoever to this land belonging or in any way appertaining
