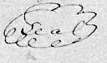

This Deed made the 14th day of December in the year of our Lord 1860, Between George W. Scott of the one part and Thomas D. B. B. B. of the other part Witnesses; that the said George W. Scott doth grant unto the said Thomas D. B. B. B. the following property, one mule, nineteen head of Hogs, one cart of wheels, with all his household & kitchen furniture. in trust to secure John D. B. B. B. in the sum of eight hundred Dollars with interest, also as security to the said George W. Scott for claims due M. D. B. B. B. for fifty Dollars more or less. The conditions of a above obligation is such that if the said George W. Scott fails to pay the debts before named when demanded, the said Thomas D. B. B. B. trustee shall after giving ten days notice sell for cash the above named property and with the proceeds thereof satisfy first John D. B. B. B. if a balance remains pay back to the said George W.
