Howard, Trustee, of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joseph Drake doth grant unto the said Henry S. Howard, Trustee, the following property: one Horse, eleven head of hogs and their increase, his crop of Corn, about thirty barrels and crop of fodder, household and kitchen furniture, consisting of three beds, bedsteads of furniture, chairs, tables, crockery ware, cooking utensils &c. and one Cart and wheels. In trust to secure the payment of a bond dated the 20th day of Decr 1860, and in default and executed by the said Joseph Drake to Benjamin O. McClure for one hundred and thirteen dollars and seventy nine cents, and, also to secure and save from all loss and damage the said Benjamin O.
