This Deed of Release, made this eighth day of January A.D. 1861,
between Jno. J. Kindred and George D. Old of the first part and James
Harrison Parker of the other part, witnesseth; that whereas the said
Parker did by Deed of Trust received in the Clerk's office of the County
Court of Southampton County, on the 16th day of January A.D. 1860,
grant and convey to the said Kindred as trustee certain property in
the said Deed of Trust mentioned, to wit; one tract of land containing
four hundred and fifty acres more or less bounded by the lands of Wm.
D. Williams, Michael Parker, his heirs, & family, Buxton, Margaret
Moon and others lying near old Smith quarry - also the following
negro slaves Man Isaac, gal Alice, and gal Betty. In trust
to secure certain debts due to the said Old from the said Parker
and in the said Deed of trust more specially described. And whereas
the said Parker has fully satisfied and paid off all of the said
debts principal and interest to the said Old.
Now this Deed witnesseth, that the said Kindred and Old for and in con-
sideration of the foregoing premises, do hereby grant and convey to the
said Parker all of the property of every kind in the said Deed of
Trust mentioned to wit; the said tract of land above described and
the said negro slaves Isaac, Alice and Betty.
