This Deed made and executed this 17th day of January in the year One thousand eight hundred & fifty, between Adolphus St. Jones of the County of a Nonpareil and State of Virginia, and Ellis Starcum & Nancy his wife, of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the one part and William H. Coy'sdale of the aforesaid County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth; That the said Adolphus St. Jones, Ellis Starcum, and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred & Twenty five Dollars to them in hand paid by the said William H. Coy'sdale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Adolphus St. Jones, Ellis Starcum & Nancy, his wife, have bargained and sold, released and confirmed unto the said William H. Coy'sdale his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land, situate lying, and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton at the west side of Black Water river marked and bounded as follows; Beginning at a pine a corner of Exum Jenkins standing on the river bank thence up said river bank several courses thereof 142 poles, to a Cypress on said river bank thence 88° W. 178 poles to a small service oak near a red oak in the late Peter Moore's line thence along S^o line S 10° E. 117 poles to a gum a corner in S^o Morris line, thence S. 63° E. 110 poles to a red oak a corner of Exum Jenkins thence N. 35° E. 153 poles
