This Deed made this first day of January 1861, between Jas Dillard and all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth: that in consideration of the sum of Seven thousand Five Hundred Dollars to them paid or secured to be paid by the said Barnes Dillard and Sarah Jane his wife, as they acknowledge, they the said Jas. and Sarah a certain tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton and adjoining the Lands of J. D. Daughtry, J. H. Croft, Meredith Holland, and Erasmus Barnett supposed to contain Seven hundred and fifty acres, be-
gard of Simon Murfee Decd.) The title whereof the said Jas. Dillard and Sarah Jane his wife doth warrant, and defend unto the said Witnesseth me hands and seals, the day and year first above written.
