Wooten & Hester A. his wife, doth grant, bargain, and sell unto the said Samuel Ford and Joseph H. Cooper, as aforesaid all their right, title and interest in and to one certain tract or parcel of land containing thirty five acres be given to them the same more or less, it being the dower right of the said Hester A.
