 This Deed made this 26th day of January in the year 1861, between John Barham of the one part, and Harrison S. Hope of the other part, Whereas by Deed dated the 10th day of October 1842, Henry Jones the grantor therein together with other property therein named conveyed to Augustin Hope all the right, title and estate which he the said Henry Jones had in and to the tract of land formerly owned by John Jones containing 120 acres more or less to secure a certain debt therein mentioned to Simon Hope, which debt was afterwards assigned by the said Simon Hope to Biny D. Hope, and the said Augustin Hope the trustee having died John Barham was appointed trustee in his place to execute said Deed by an order of the County Court of Southampton County made the 23rd day of January 1861. And whereas by another Deed dated the 30th day of November 1849, the said Henry Jones, the grantor therein conveyed to the said John Barham, as trustee, a certain tract or parcel of land wherein the said Jones lived with appraised County of Southampton, adjoining the lands of James W. Wrenn, Alstina Hope, Harkwell Wrenn and others containing one hundred and forty acres more or less, to secure a certain debt therein mentioned to B. D. & H. S. Hope both of which Deeds are recorded in Southampton County Court. And whereas the said John Barham by direction of the beneficiaries in said Deeds, did, after having duly advertised the said land, set up the same with the 26th day of January 1861, at auction to the highest bidder for cash, when Harrison S. Hope became the purchaser thereof at the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars. Now this Deed witnesseth, that the said John Barham for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty dollars, doth grant unto the said Harrison S. Hope the said tract of land, as above described with special warranty. Witness the following signature of seal.
