

County and State above mentioned, and which is known and described as follows to wit, bounded on the East and South east by Roanokee Run to a point at the Southern extremity, where the said Roanokee Run enters into Seacock Swamp, thence up the said Seacock Swamp in a Northwesterly direction forming a part of its Western boundary, the remainder of the west and the North being bound by the lands of the said Ex'mt W. Shields to the said Roanokee run, whence the above eastern boundary commenced containing eight and three fifths acres with all its appurtenances, title and interest of the said Ex'mt W. Shields of the first part, thereto. And the said Ex'mt W. Shields of the first part doth hereby grant, bargain, and sell to Robert Hawls of the second part, the lawful owner of the premises above granted in fee simple absolute and that he will warrant and defend the above granted premises in the quiet and peaceful possession of the said Robert Hawls of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.

And the said Ex'mt W. Shields of the first part, doth further grant unto the said Robert Hawls of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the privilege of cutting a ditch or Canal across the land of the said Shields for the purpose of draining the portion of land which the said Ex'mt W. Shields has sold to the said Robert Hawls.

This Deed made this 1st day of January 1861, between W^m R. Briggs Commissioner appointed by a Decree of the County Court of Southampton at August term 1858 to sell a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in said County belonging to the estate of Fielding J. Mahone one of the two parts and James Holt of the other part. Whereas it is agreed that the said W^m R. Briggs Commissioner as aforesaid in consideration of one hundred Dollars to him paid by said James Holt, doth bargain and sell unto said James Holt a certain tract or parcel of land in said County described lying in said County, containing by estimation Sixteen & $\frac{1}{3}$ acres more or less unto the said James Holt of his heirs forever conveying only such title as said said Land as Commissioner aforesaid.
