to Nathaniel Care & Reddick Gattings Jr. in the following sum one
note amounting to twenty nine hundred and thirty three dollars and
twenty one cents, dated and bearing interest from the date of these
present. Now to have the aforementioned Care & Gattings harmless
which the said Newson Holland and his wife Elizabeth A. D. Hol-
land desire to do and to pay said debt. Now for and in consideration
of these presents and the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the
said Nathaniel Care & R. Gattings Jr. both bargain, grant, sell and
convey unto the said Nathaniel Care & Reddick Gattings Jr. their
heirs and assigns forever our left right in the following negro
servants, Jacob, Hannu, Catharine, Joe, Caroline, Moore, Mary,
Magg, Mary, and Ellen, also the following property, thirty
hogs, and their increase, one horse and one cow and her
increase, one buggy and harness, one cart and wheels, four feather beds,
one furniture, one dozen chairs, three tables, one press and all the
household and kitchen furniture of every description all the corn,
feed and pease now on hand and all the crops for the ensuing
