George Bryant & wife  
to Jonathan Darden  
Dowries Trustee  
This Deed made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of March in the year 1861, between George Bryant  
and of Martha his wife, of the first part and Henry F. Howard Trustee of the  
second part, witnesseth, That the said George Bryant of Martha his wife,  
do grant unto the said Henry F. Howard, trustee, with general warranty the  
following property, to wit; a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in  
the County of Southampton, adjoining the lands of John H. Scarborough, to him  
supposed to contain one hundred and forty six acres more or less, being the same  
tract or parcel of land purchased by the said George Bryant of Joseph S.  
Judd his wife by Deed dated the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1857, and recorded in the  
Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court, on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1857  
In trust to secure the payment of a bond bearing even date with this Deed  
(to wit, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1861,) executed by the said George Bryant  
to Jonathan Darden for the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars  
payable on Demand. And it is agreed by and between the  
said Jonathan Darden & George Bryant that he the said Jonathan  
Darden will wait with & indulge him the said George Bryant in the  
payment of the principal of the said bond for the sum of three years  
from the date of this Deed; provided he the said George Bryant  
shall pay to him the said Jonathan Darden the interest which shall  
accrue annually on said bond up to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March of the  
respective years 1862, 3, 4, &c. But it is further agreed by the  
parties to this Deed that in the event of the failure of the  
said George Bryant to pay to the said Jonathan Darden the  
interest annually on the said bond to become due on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
March of the years 1865, 3, 4, 5, when the same shall become  
due is demanded by the said Jonathan Darden at either of the said dates, it shall  
be the duty of the said trustee under this Deed when requested by the said Jonathan  
Darden to sell the said land after duly advertising the same, and after paying  
the costs of this trust, then pay the said bond & all interest which shall  
have accrued on the same & remaining unpaid to the said Jonathan Daren,  
and the balance if any, pay over to the said George Bryant or
