Halfield This Deed made the 18th day of January in year 1861, between William Hatfield of the one part and James B. Vick (the trustee) of the other part, Witness that that the said William Hatfield doth grant unto the said James B. Vick with general warranty of the following property, my plantation, whereon I am living containing one hundred acres more or less adjoining the lands of Matthew Harris, Patrick Howe, W^m Drake, Eliza Harris and W^m Lankford Senr. and four beds and furniture, one bedstead and chairs, four ten chairs, one Walnut Table, one pine table, kitchen utensils, fourteen head of hogs, and their increase, one horse, two work oxen, one cow yearling and their increase, eight sheep and their increase, thirteen hundred pounds of Rock, twenty barrels of long corn, two thousand pounds of Blad. fodder, also my crops of all kinds. In trust to secure William Weston and A. W. Mofflet, William Weston's amount of bonds due him, one bond due January the 31st 1861, twenty two dollars, one bond due January the 13th 1861, for forty one dollar and thirty cents, one bond due May 1st 1861, twenty eight dollars and seventy five cents, Amount of bonds due A. W. Mofflet, one bond due February the 16th 1868, twenty dollars and twenty six cents. Bond due January 3rd 1860 for forty seven dollars and seventy one cents, one bond due January 7th 1861 twenty dollars and forty eight cents. Witness the following signature and seals.

Johnson's This Deed made the 18th day of January 1861, between Zachary J. Johnson, Martha W. Johnson, & William V. Corbit of the one part and John W. Corbit of the other part, Witness that, that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars the said Zachary J. Johnson, Martha W. Johnson & William V. Corbit do grant all their right, title and interest in a certain quarter parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and containing thirty seven and half acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows; on the North by the lands of Levi Farmer, on the east by the land of Samuel Corbit, on the South by the lands of David Lawrence, on the West by Ballards Mill Pond, dividing it from the lands of William C. Thimmon
