life then with remainder in fee simple to the aforesaid Richard Barrett his  
heirs and assigns herein referred to before and the said Richard Barrett his  
is hereby authorized and required to rent and hire out the said Land and  
slaves and invest the said money as he may deem best for the advan-  
tage of the said Erastus, and to use and employ the property hereby  
conveyed to him of all kinds, as in his judgment may be best for the  
interest of the said Erastus, and shall account to the said Erastus and pay over  
to him the rents issues and profits of the said property as he the said  
Erastus may require, and upon the death of the said Erastus, in the  
manner indicated and declared above by the provisions of this  
deed, and authority is hereby vested in the said Richard Barrett to sell the  
said lands and slaves or any of them, if he shall deem it judicious or proper  
any time so to do, and to reinvest the proceeds of such sale or sales in  
such manner as he may deem best for the interest of the said Eras-  
tus, such investments to be made and held by him subject to all the  
provisions and stipulations of this deed.

acres more or less being in the County of Southampton, bounded by the  
land of said J. V. Cloud, J. W. Cloud, & others with all the ap-  
pertinences therewith belonging or in any wise appertaining and we do  
hereby covenant with said Jesse C. Cloud, that we have before  
the execution of this Deed, full right, absolute and lawfull authority  
to sell the said land and agree hereby to warrant and forever defend  
the right title of the same to him the said Jesse C. Cloud
