Briggs of the other part, Witnessed that the said Selvey Bygones for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and fifty dollars, doth grant with general warranty unto the said Thomas M. Briggs a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing forty eight acres, being the same tract of land which was allotted her as one of the Hollanday Tribe of Indians out of the land held in common by the said Hottoway tribe of Indians at the October term 1851, of Southampton County Court.
