Rose of the other part, Whitefield; that whereas the said Bindred by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County rendered at the May term thereof A.D. 1858, was appointed a special Commissioner to sell the real estate in the proceedings mentioned (the style of which suit is Amos S. Rose v. Claude) of which said real estate Nathan Rose had seized and which is supposed to contain four hundred and sixty acres more or less and is bounded by the lands of Richard David Jacob Williams, George Rose and Giles Rose and whereas the said Amos S. Rose became the Purchaser of the said real estate for the sum of fifteen hundred dollars and has paid to the said Bindred the sum of Seven hundred and eight dollars and seventy five cents with legal interest current to this day.
