The said Lewis Wmell is now dead and Jos. G. Gellie, Esq. E. Wmell & Rob^t S. Barnes are his heirs. By his will and I by this writing bind myself & my heirs to deliver to the said Gellie, Wmell & Barnes or their heirs the said negro girl Lucy when she arrives to the age of fifteen years which will be on the 1st day of June 1861. Given under my hand and seal this 17th day of June 1861.
