Witnesseth, that in consideration of thirty dollars in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Eliza J. Dillard doth grant unto the said Stewart Branch all that tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, and bounded North & East by the lands of Charles Scammell and the lands lately belonging to John Frisash and Milton D. Butler and South & West by the lands of Miles Scarborough dec. and John B. Barrett and Stewart Branch, to have and to hold to him and his heirs forever. And the said grantor releases to the said grantee all her claims upon the said lands. Witness the following signature and seals.

This Deed made this 22^d August 1861 between Jas^r M. Burley of the first part and James Griffin of the second part. Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars the said Jas^r M. Burley doth grant unto the said James Griffin all right, title, interest or demand in and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated about five miles East of Jerusalem immediately on the Black road and known as the Meahum tract, and bounded as follows to wit. Commencing at a Stony cross, a corner in Cherry Lane line, thence a Southeast course to a Black gum, corner in Eliza Dillard's line, thence near the road of
