South & West by the lands of Miles Scarborough dec'd and John B. Barrett and Newell Branch. to have and
to hold to him and his heirs forever. and the said grantee releases to the said grantor all her claims upon

Griffin of the second part. Witneseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty
dollars the said Jno. M. Gurley doth grant unto the said James Griffin all right, title, interest or demand he
and to a certain tract or parcel of land situated about five miles East of Jerusalem immediately on the Black road
and known as the Meckham tract, and bound as follows to wit. Commencing at a Honey locust, a corner in
Sherry Lovers line, thence a South east course to a Black gum, corner in Eliza Dillards line, then near the end of
