 of his estate in 1836 and containing by estimation three hundred and eighty one acres, more or less, for
 and during the life of the said Maria E Phillips yealding therefor One hundred and twenty five dollars
 to be paid annual on the 1st day of January of each year and all the taxes on said land, with this exception
 that the said Rich'd J Darden promised to buy the said dinner after twenty four months, and the said
 A. P. Phillips and Maria his wife reserves the right to sell the said dinner after twenty four months has
 elapsed to any person who will buy it, giving Rich'd J Darden the preference. Witnes the following
