This Deed made this twenty second day of November in the year 1861 between Caroline W Thorp of the first part and Archer Vick of the other part WITNESSETH that the said Caroline W Thorp for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred thirty seven dollars & fifty cents paid to the said Caroline W Thorp by the said Archer Vick, the receipt whereof the said Caroline W Thorp doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold & by this deed grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said Archer Vick a certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton, State of Va. and bounded on the South and West by the lands belonging to the heirs of Caleb Overitt, on the North by the lands belonging to Benjamin J Bryant & on the East by the lands of Joseph Ferguson, supposed to contain One hundred twenty & 1/2 acres, be the same more or less, together with all and every privilege, right and appurtenances belonging to the said tract or parcel of land. It have and to hold the said lands and all the privileges, rights and appurtenances belonging thereto unto him the said Archer Vick his heirs and assigns in fee simple, and the said Caroline W Thorp for herself and her heirs do hereby covenant & agree to & with the said Archer Vick and his heirs that she the said Caroline W Thorp and unto him the said Archer Vick his heirs & assigns the said tract of land hereby conveyed together with all & every privilege, right and appurtenance thereto belonging against the claim & demand of all and every other person claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof shall and will by this deed forever warrant and defend and that she the said Caroline W Thorp has the right to convey the said land to the said Archer Vick and that the said Archer Vick shall have quiet possession of the said land. IN WITNESS whereof the said Caroline W Thorp have hereunto set her hand & affixed her seal the 25th day of November 1861.
