This Deed made this the eighteenth day of February eight hundred and fifty seven doth witness: that
Richard A. Urquhart and Mary R his wife of the County of Sole of Wight of the one part do grant, bargain
and Sell to Joseph T. W. Summerville of the County of Southampton of the other part, for and in consideration of the
Sum of thirty five hundred dollars (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) a certain tract of land known
and designated as Urquharts new Store, lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing eight
hundred and fifty acres more or less. The said tract of land is bounded by, or more on the one side, by the
lightwood swamp, the land of Shadrach Boykin & Mrs. O. G. Gray, Cary Gay, Mrs. Polly Brindle and Jesse
Branch. This deed also witnesseth that the said R. A. Urquhart and Mary R his wife do reserve to themselves
on the said tract of land the Store house with all of its appurtenances to be removed at their discretion - and they do
warrant generally the right and title hereby conveyed. Given under their hands and seals the above day and
