This Deed made this seventh day of February One thousand eight hundred and fifty two, between Eli Bradshaw and Catherine his wife of the one part and Thomas J. Proctor of the other part, all of the County of Southampton Va. Witneseth, that in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars in hand paid to the said Eli Bradshaw by the said Proctor, the said Bradshaw and wife doth grant, bargaint and sell to the said Proctor all that tract or parcel of land on which the said Bradshaw now resides, containing two hundred and thirty six acres, to the same more or less and bounded as follows - North by the lands of Moses Joyner, East and South by the lands of Edmon A. Williams and T. J. Proctor and West by the land of George Bryant, and which land was purchased by the said Bradshaw of Putnam Orren, William A. Bell and Benj. W. Dunn and by these presents the said Bradshaw and wife hath granted bargained and sold to the said Proctor and his heirs the said land together with all its appurtenances to have and to hold forever against the claims of the said Bradshaw, and the title to which he binds himself to defend against the claims of all persons claiming by or through him and against all other persons whomsoever.
