 and Catharine Bradshaw the wife of said Eli personally appeared before me in my Office and being examined  
 by me privately and apart from her husband, and having due written fully explained to her, the said Catharine  
 Bradshaw acknowledged the same to be her act and declared that she had executed it willingly and did not wish to  
 retract it. Whereupon the said deed is admitted to Record.

This Deed made and entered into on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord, eighteen  
 hundred and sixty two between Martha Cobb of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia  
 of the one part and Robert Williams of the said County and State of the other part witnesseth, that  
 the said Martha Cobb for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars to her in hand paid  
 by the said Robert Williams at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant,  
 bargain and sell unto him the said Robert Williams his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or  
 parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of  
 Saint Lukes, containing by estimation twelve acres be the same more or less lying on the south side  
 of bean creek and bounded by the lands of Benjamin J. Bryant the heirs of Isle Whitley dec'd and  
 Robert Williams. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises  
 with the appurtenances whereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said Robert Williams  
 his heirs and assigns forever. As and for the only proper use and behoef of him the said Robert Williams  
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Martha Cobb for herself her heirs. Executors and administrators  
 doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Robert Williams his heirs. Executors, administrators  
 and assigns that she will by these warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid  
 tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging, against the claims or  
 demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever. On witness wherof the said Martha  
 Cobb hath hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first above written.

This Deed made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year 1862 between L.R. Edwards and W.  
 Atkinson of the one part and Elisha Lewis of the other part. Witnesseth, that whereas the said Elisha Lewis  
 of Atkinson his wife by deed admitted to record on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1861 did convey to the said L.R. Edwards  
 a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County containing two hundred and eighty one and one  
 half acres more or less and more particularly described in said deed. In trust to secure William  
 Atkinson as his the said Elisha Lewis security to a bond due Alfred T. Stephenson for eight hundred  
 and fifty nine  $\frac{56}{100}$  Dollars. And whereas since the execution of the said aforesaid, the said Elisha Lewis  
 has paid off and discharged the bond aforesaid thereby releasing the said Atkinson as his security  
 therefore the said L.R. Edwards in consideration of the premises and with the consent of the said William  
 Atkinson signified by his signing these presents, doth hereby release and recover unto the said  
 Elisha Lewis the tract of land herein before mentioned and described with special warranty.
