Joyner, J. W. Duck and Arthur Johnson. This said Exam^r L Crumpler covenants that he will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signature and seal.

This deed made on this fourteenth day of November in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty two between Thomas H. Urquhart party of the first part and Francis C Williams party of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars paid to the party of the first part, the receipt of which he hereby acknowledges, he the said Thomas H. Urquhart does give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Francis C Williams and his heirs forever with general warranty the tract of land in the County and State above named known as the Dick's Hinds tract containing three hundred and twenty acres more or less. for boundaries see deed from J. C. James to T. H. Urquhart. The said T. H. Urquhart covenants that he has the right to convey the said land to the grantee, that he has done no act to encumber the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land free from all encumbrances; and that he the said party of the first part, will execute such further assurances of the said land as may be required. Williams of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Richard Williams & wife for & in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Augustus W. Williams, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargain'd, sold & delivered, by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Augustus W. Williams his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, & bounded as follows. Beginning at the East side of a road running near the seat Richard Williams, thence up Round hill branch to Urquhart's line, on the West to a mill pond. Thence down Blows line to the Road, & containing, by late survey, two hundred and twelve acres, more or less, together with all and singular the privileges & appurtenances whatsoever
