This Deed made this 1st day of January in the year 1861 between Ben. J. Pope and his wife Ann of the one part and Elliot St. Pope of the other part. Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars the said Pope and his wife do grant unto the said Elliot St. Pope their interest (say one half) of the tract of land on which the said Ben. J. Pope formerly resided, containing by estimation one hundred and twenty four acres, more or less, lying in the County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of B. B. Kindred, C. D. Barkham Nancy Powell and others likewise their interest (say one half) of the tract of land known as the Story tract containing by estimation forty one acres, more or less, lying in the said County and adjoining the lands of C. D. Barkham Nancy Powell and the tract above granted, together with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging; and the said Pope and wife do covenant with the said Elliot St. Pope, that they are seized in fee of the above granted premises, that they have a right to sell and convey the same and that they will warrant and defend the right thereof to the said Elliot St. Pope and his heirs against the lawful claims of all persons.
