1857 May 20th Rec^d two hundred and fifty dollars in part of within - A Faison.
July 7th 1863 Received of Samuel St Holmes the sum of two hundred and one dollars fifty one cts
being the balance due as payment in full of the within note.

At Faison for P. J. Holmes

At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 16th day of February 1863.
Whereas two Deeds of trust having been executed by Phineas M Bailey, the dates whereof not recollect-
ed, for the same with other records of the County of Southampton having been removed in consequence of
the proximity of the public enemy, conveying certain property, real and personal to Jos. T. H. Sumner
et al trustee for the benefit of A. Faison & others. And whereas the said Joseph T. H. Summerville being
dead, the Court appointed Mary L Bailey in the place of the said Summerville to execute said trust;
and she refusing to act, the parties concerning their interest under the peculiar condition of public
affairs required instant action did appoint Samuel St Holmes trustee to act in the premises. Where-
upon the said Holmes did proceed to sell the said property in the Deeds of trust mentioned, as will
appear by his account of sales herewith filed & ordered to be and did and recorded and paid the debt
due Faison as will also appear by his bond secured by said deeds also returned & herewith filed.
And it appearing that Theadus Bailey, Joseph Bailey, Eliza Bailey & Junius Bailey, who being
minors, are entitled to with Phineas M Bailey Jr & Mary L Bailey, the two last being adults, to
the balance in the hands of said Sam. St. Holmes trustee the Court acting in behalf of said minors,
being of opinion that the exigencies of the times, and the condition of the parties (the minor parties
being actually suffering for food) interested demanded immediate action, the adult parties having
consented thereto, doth hereby ratify the appointment of the said Holmes as trustee, and doth appoint
him; and the Court doth further ratify and confirm the sale made by him, and doth authorize him to
execute all deeds and papers that may be necessary to convey title to the property sold. And the
Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that a Commissioner of this Court, settle the transactions
of said trustee in the premises and ascertain the amounts severally due to the parties, aforesaid
entitled to the said balance remaining in the hands of the said trustee and make report to Court,
with such other matters as may be required by the parties to be stated, or as he may deem pertinent.
