
This Indenture made the fifth day of February 1863 between Jordan Spring of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Eli Spring of the second part. Witness, that the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of \$1000 Dollars lawful money of V. to him in hand paid before delivery hereof both bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant and convey to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of V. and which is describe as follows. To wit, Commencing at cr. pins or hoods line, thence a straight line N 30 E 69 poles to a post oak, thence S 25 W 45 poles to a cr. thence N 45 E 72 poles to a maple cr. of hoods line, thence S 45 W 92 poles to be Sweet gum on the ditch thence S 25 W 42 poles to a large black gum in the old pond branch thence along the various courses of said branch 86 poles to the first Station, containing forty two acres or the same more or less, together with all and singular appurtenments, hereditaments, appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part thence and the said party of the first doth hereby consent and agree with the said party of the second part that at the time of the delivery hereof the said party of the first is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and barges thereof in fee simple absolute and that he will warrant and defend the above granted premises in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
