Joyner, Mathew Williams, Shet. Ball, Eliza Howell and others of Burbage containing fourteen acres more or less and the right to this she does forever warrant and defend to Wm. Brantley and his heirs. This Deed made this 16th day of October 1860 between Richard Barrett and Mary R his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Uriah Bracy of the said County and State of the other part, conditioned that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid by the said Uriah Bracy, the said Richard Barrett and Mary R his wife doth grant unto the said Uriah Bracy the following property to wit. One lot of land lying in the aforesaid County and State and in Land near the Village of Franklin depot on the north east side of the County road leading from Franklin Depot to Blackwater or Suffolk, commencing first within five and a half feet of a small red oak, top near the side of the said road running N 69° E Seventy yds thence S 19° E Seventy yds thence S 69° W Seventy yds thence N 19° W Seventy yds to the beginning, making one acre of land.
