This Deed made this 2nd day of January in the year eighteen hundred and sixty four between
 Sherrod Smith of the City of Petersburg of the one part and George W Spivey of Southampton
 County Virginia of the other part With of both that in consideration of the sum of Four hundred
 dollars the said Sherrod Smith doth grant and convey unto the said George W Spivey the following
 property to wit One certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia, bounded as follows to wit. On the North by the lands
 of John Spivey, East by the lands of Wm Spivey, South by Hannah Branch, and West by Har-
 ven Swamp containing One hundred acres, it being a part of the land conveyed to said Sherrod
 Smith by Edw Butts and A. Atkinson and wife by deed dated the 2nd day of July 1858
 and duly recorded in the Clerks Office of Southampton County, to which reference is here made for
 further description. And the said Sherrod Smith hereby covenants to and with the said George

This Deed made this 18th day of January 1864 between Wm Grayard of the County of
 Southampton and William P Harris acting as commissioners under a decree of the County Court of
 Southampton obtained at the term 1861. Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of twenty
 six hundred & 11 dollars, he the said Wm P. Harris has sold to the said William Grayard a certain
