This Deed made this 2^d day of January in the year eighteen hundred and sixty four between Sherrod Smith of the City of Petersburg of the one part and George W. Spivey of Southampton County, Virginia of the other part witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Four hundred dollars the said Sherrod Smith doth grant and convey unto the said George W. Spivey the following property to wit One certain tract, piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, bounded as follows to wit On the North by the limits of John Spivey, East by the lands of Wm. Spivey, South by Hannah Branch, and West by Horse Pen Swamp containing One hundred acres, it being a part of the land conveyed to said Sherrod Smith by Edw^r Batts and A. Atkinson and w^t w^t by deed dated the 1st day of July 1854 and duly recorded in the Clerks Office of Southampton County, to which reference is here made for further description.
