of the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Johnson at or before the delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do, and each of them doth grant, bargain and sell to him the said Jordan & Johnson his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, containing two hundred & ninety six acres more or less and bounded by the lands of the heirs of John Johnson & Miss Ann Battle the said William D. Bryant & Margaret his wife conveying tract or parcel of land and promises with all and singular its appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said J. E. Johnson his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William D. Bryant and Margaret his wife for themselves their heirs, Executors & administrators do, and each of them doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said J. E. Johnson his heirs and assigns that they will by these presents warrant forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and promises hereby conveyed against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
