This deed made the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March in the year 1864, between Levi W Stephenson and  
Elizabeth L Stephenson his wife of the first part and Sylvanus Strick of the second part, all of  
the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of  
Nine hundred dollars, the said Levi W Stephenson and Elizabeth L Stephenson his wife doth grant  
unto the said Sylvanus Strick all their right, title and interest in one certain tract or parcels of land  
containing by estimation three hundred and sixty one acres, to the same more or less, bounded on the  
South by the lightwood Swamp and the lands of John J Holmes on the West and North, and the  
lands belonging to the estate of Drury Pond on the East. Witnesseth the following signatures  
and seals.

Twenty four hundred dollars to me in hand paid the said James H Mangum do grant unto the said William Prince  
all right title and interest in a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, Virginia  
containing 506 acres to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Joseph H Drury, Mr Job Ward  
and Williams Prince.
