This Deed made this tenth day of March in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty four, between Elizabeth A Turner, William A Jones and wife Martha L E Jones, George W Turner, and James E P. Turner and wife Ann Maria D Turner (grantors) of the first part and Benjamin E Turner (grantee) of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth: that the said grantors, hereby bargain and sell to the said grantee, and for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand and five hundred (\$1500.00 cents) dollars to them paid by the said grantee, the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey to the said grantee, the said B. E. Turner, all the right title and interest of every kind whatever, which the said parties of the first or either of them may now own or possess, no matter in what manner acquired, or may hereafter acquire by descent, in and to all the real estate lying in the said County, of which William T Turner died seized and possessed: that is to say, all the right and interest which the said grantors may now have or may hereafter acquire by descent, in and to the tract of land which was granted and conveyed to the said William D Turner by Lewis Harris now deceased and which was purchased by the said Harris at the sale of Benjamin Turner deceased, father of the said grantee, supposed to contain two hundred and twenty acres more or less. and in like manner all their interest in and to the tract or parcel of land which was granted and conveyed to the said William by James Turner now deceased, supposed to contain one hundred and thirty acres more or less - which two said parcels of land join each other and are bounded by the flat swamp, the lands of Henry Wood deceased, Richard Harris and Nathan A Thomas, and by those of said grantee - Witness the following signatures and seals.
