rights, title, interest, property claims and demands whatsoever in law, equity or otherwise of her the
said Elizabeth of in and to a certain tract of parcel of land, situate and being in said County
bounded as follows by the lands of Elizabeth H. Turner, Richard Harris, Wm. C. Pope and
John A. Person dec^d containing eight hundred acres be the same more or less, doeth neither
she the said Elizabeth, her heirs, Executors, Administrators or assigns, nor any other person or
persons for her shall have, claim, challenge or demand, any dower or thirds or right thereto,
in whatsoever hands begin, professed the same may or can be, but thereof and therefrom shall be

This deed made the 22nd day of March in the year 1864, between Alpheus W Ocker and Rebecca
A his wife of the County of Sussex of the one part and Benjamin A Travis of the County of Southampton
of the other part, Witnesses, that in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid
at and before the executing and delivering of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they
the said A. W Ocker and Rebecca A his wife doth grant unto Benjamin A Travis and to his heirs all that
tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing One hundred and Sixty (160) acres
be the same more or less and bounded as follows Viz: On the North by the lands of John Hines
on the east and south by the lands of Solomon Hines and on the West by the lands of Benjamin
Travis. To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of land to him the said Benjamin A Travis
and his heirs forever free from the claim and claims of them the said Alpheus W Ocker and Rebecca
A his wife and from all and every person or persons whomsoever. Witnesses the following signatures
