Butts dec^d and for the further consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars do grant, sell and convey
unto the said Benj^e E Cobb the tract of land lying on the West side of Indian Branch purchased
by Edwards Butts in his lifetime from Etheldreda Drake bounded on the West by the Indian Branch
on the South by the land purchased by the said Benjamin E Cobb from Cornish Cobb, on the east
by the tract belonging to John Simmonds, and on the North by the tract purchased by Wm A Bell
at the sale of the said J.T. Butts dec^d containing by estimation ninety one acres to the same more or less
being all of the said Etheldreda Drake tract except that part lying East of the Indian branch. And

and defend the title to the said land against the lawful claims of all persons holding by or through
them, but against the claims of no other person whatsoever.
